The Principal & Chairman, Dr.V.Thirunavukkarasu, welcomed and felicitated University Nominees, Academic Experts, Industry Experts and other Members of the Tenth Academic Council meeting.

The Controller of Examinations, Dr.P.Thirumal, with the consent of the Chairman conveyed the agenda and the proceedings of Tenth Academic Council Meeting which started at 11.05 a.m.

Agenda – 10.1 Actions Taken on the Report of the 9th Academic Council Meeting.

The Controller of Examinations, Dr. P. Thirumal, presented the Minutes of the 9th Academic Council Meeting along with the Action Taken Report on the decisions and resolutions of the Council. After due deliberation, the Academic Council Members reviewed and approved the Minutes and the Action Taken Report.

Agenda – 10.2 Approval of Regulations 2025 (UG/PG).

The Deputy Controller of Examinations, Dr. C. M. T. Karthikeyan, presented the Regulations 2025 for Undergraduate (Full-Time and Part-Time) and Postgraduate programmes. The Academic Council carefully reviewed the regulations and, after detailed deliberation, approved the Regulations 2025 for implementation.

Agenda – 10.3 Approval of Curriculum and Syllabi up to four semesters for all departments under Regulations 2025.

10.3.1 Department of Computer Science and Engineering (CSE)

The following points were recommended by the committee for third semester syllabus:

1. Database and Management Systems: Inclusion of GitHub-related content in the course.

2. Database and Management Systems Laboratory: Laboratory exercises should be designed as generic exercises rather than based on specific problem statements.
3. Object Oriented Programming: The course structure may be revised to include four units on C++ and one unit on Java.
4. Object Oriented Programming Laboratory: Assignments and task-based activities may be included for students.

Since the semester has already commenced, the above recommendations cannot be incorporated into the current syllabus. However, these suggestions may be considered during the formulation of the next set of Regulations. In the meantime, necessary steps will be taken to provide suitable activities, assignments, or task-based exercises related to the above recommendations wherever feasible.

Recommendations of the Committee for Fourth Semester:

The following points were recommended by the committee for fourth semester syllabus:

1. Computer Organization and Architecture: Include contents on RISC architecture and Real-Time Operating Systems in the course.
2. Operating Systems: The committee suggested incorporating introductory topics on Real-Time Operating Systems (RTOS).
3. Software Engineering: Inclusion of Software Quality fundamentals contents in the course.

The above recommendations will be incorporated into the fourth semester syllabus.

General recommendations by the Committee:

The committee recommended encouraging interdisciplinary projects involving students from different departments to promote collaborative learning, innovation, and the application of multidisciplinary knowledge.

10.3.2 Department of Computer Science and Engineering (Cyber Security)

1. "Number systems" topic should be included in the first unit of the subject "Digital Principles and Computer Organization" which is in Semester III.
2. Change the title as "Operating Systems and Security Laboratory" instead of "Operating Systems and Security in Kali Linux Laboratory" in Semester IV.

10.3.3 Department of Electronics and Communication Engineering (ECE)

The Academic Council made the following recommendations for incorporation in the R2025 Curriculum and Syllabi:

1. III Semester – 25LPC302: Electronic Circuits
The tutorial hours allocated for Unit IV and Unit V may be increased.
2. III Semester – 25LPC303: Digital Electronics
The syllabus content prescribed for Unit IV may be reduced.

3. IV Semester – 25LPC402: Electronic Devices and Circuits
CMOS and TTL amplifier circuits may be included in Unit I.
4. IV Semester – 25LPC403: Microprocessor and Microcontroller
Greater weightage may be given to 8051 microcontroller programming and interfacing in comparison with the 8086 microprocessor.
5. IV Semester – 25LPC405: Control Systems
Applications of frequency-domain analysis may be included in the syllabus.
6. IV Semester – 25LPC409: Microprocessor and Microcontroller Laboratory
The headings under the List of Experiments may be revised as follows:

8086 Microprocessor-Based Experiments

8051 Microcontroller-Based Experiments

in place of:

8086 Programs using Kits and MASM

8051 Experiments using Kits and MASM

10.3.4 Department of Electrical and Electronics Engineering (EEE)

1. In the subject 25EPC305-Digital Logic Circuits, the council members asked to replace Verilog coding for basic digital Structures (Gates, Flip-Flops, Adders and Counters) instead of VHDL Coding for basic digital Structures (Gates, Flip-Flops, Adders and Counters) under the heading of Design and Implementation of Logic Circuits.
2. In the Subject 25EPC403- Synchronous and Asynchronous Machines, members suggested to include the topic of PMSM under the heading of Single Phase Induction Motors and Special Machines.
3. In the subject 25EPC405- Linear Integrated Circuits and Applications members informed to have the topic of CMOS &TTL at the circuit level under the heading of Basics and Characteristics of OP-AMP.
4. Also, in the same subject, members suggested to include Artificial Intelligence (AI) based ICs under the heading of Special ICs and Applications.
5. In the subject 25EPC408- Linear and Digital Integrated Circuits and Applications Laboratory, the experiment Introduction to VHDL Simulation is changed to Verilog Simulation as per theory content change.
6. It is unanimously decided in the council meeting to have course duration as 7 Semesters ($3\frac{1}{2}$ years) for B.E.- Electrical and Electronics Engineering (Part Time) in order to cater the total credit requirement for the Programme from the academic year 2025-26 onwards.

10.3.5 Department of Mechanical Engineering

1. Committee has recommended to revise and reduce 25MES308 Embedded Systems and IoT content suitable for a 2-credit course.

2. In the activities of each course it is recommended to replace solving GATE examination questions into solving MCQs.

Resolution: Syllabus will be revised accordingly.

The Academic Council Members reviewed the R-2025 Curriculum and Syllabi of all the departments. After incorporating the recommendations and modifications suggested by the Council, the Curriculum and Syllabi under Regulation 2025 (R-2025) were approved for implementation.

Agenda – 10.4 Graduation day Statistics.

The Controller of Examinations, Dr. P. Thirumal, presented the graduation statistics of the year 2024 and 2025 for both the Undergraduate (UG) and Postgraduate (PG) programmes.
