RULES & INSTRUCTIONS**

(Coordinators may add/Delete the Rules and Regulation for smooth conduct of the events)

POETRY CONTEST:

- Individual participation only.
- Entries can be in English or Tamil.
- Both classical and modern styles are allowed.
- Participants may choose any theme.
- All forms of poetry are permitted – haiku, long forms, traditional, or contemporary.
- Participants will be given one hour to compose and present their poem.
- Late submissions beyond the time limit may not be accepted.
- The poem must be original and created during the competition.
- Plagiarism or copying from existing works will lead to disqualification.
- Content must not include offensive, inappropriate, or discriminatory language.

SHORT STORY WRITING:

- The competition is open to individual participants only.
- Stories can be written in English or Tamil.
- The theme/topic: Migration.
- Participants will be allotted to complete their story within the time.
- The story must be original and written during the contest.
- Plagiarism or copying from existing works will lead to disqualification.
- Word limit (if needed) may be set by the organizers; participants should ensure clarity and coherence.
- Offensive, discriminatory, or inappropriate content is strictly prohibited

PODCAST COMPETITION:

- This is an individual event.
- The theme/topic: democracy in Today's India.
- Participants must record and play a one-minute audio on the given theme.
- The audio can be a monologue or a dialogue.
- The total duration for the event is 3 minutes.

SPEECH COMPETITION:

- The competition is open to individual participants only.
- The theme/topic: My Dream World.
- Each participant will be allotted 3 minutes to deliver their speech.
- Speeches may be delivered in English/Tamil (specify whichever language(s) you prefer).
- Use of offensive, discriminatory, or inappropriate content will lead to disqualification.

COMMENTARY CONTEST RULES:

- Individual participants only.
- The theme/topic: From Home to College.
- Participants will have one hour to prepare and present their commentary.
- Language: Speeches can be delivered in English or Tamil.
- Content must be original and created by the participant.
- Use of offensive, discriminatory, or inappropriate language will lead to disqualification.

BUDGET BATTLE:

- The team must only contain 2–4 members per team.
- Teams must not exceed the given budget.
- Virtual budget only.
- Plans must directly relate to the announced theme at the time of the event.
- Teams will be given list of resources with their prices and their final take on the project or idea will be explained at the proposed time.
- Entire presentation must be in English.
- Copying or using pre-prepared plans will lead to disqualification.

TREASURE HUNT:

- Team participation with a maximum of 4 to 6 members.
- All teams must assemble at the open stage before the hunt begins.
- The first clue will be given at the starting point.
- Clues will be placed at different locations across the campus.
- Each clue must be decoded to move on to the next spot.
- Every clue has to be signed by the in-charge at that location.
- Only teams with all signed clues are eligible to receive the final clue.
- The first team to decode the final clue and discover the treasure will be the winner.
- Teams must not tamper with or hide clues meant for others.
- Skipping spots, damaging property, or using unfair means will lead to disqualification.
- Participants must stay within the campus area.

COLLEGE 2.0 (TECH கலக்குவோம்):

- Participation can be as an individual or as a team.
- Team participation is restricted to a maximum of 3 members.
- Participants can use their mobile phones or laptops.
- The theme is to address "Problems in your college life".
- Participants are required to build simple solutions to these problems, such as waste management or digital attendance.
- Specific topics will be given on the day of the competition.
- The duration is 30 minutes for deliberation and 3 minutes to present before the jury.

SOLO SINGING:

- This is an individual event.
- Participants can sing film songs, devotional songs, or folk songs.
- The duration of the performance is 3 to 4 minutes.

INSTRUMENTALS:

- This is an individual event.
- Participants can play any musical instrument listed in the rules.
- Participants must bring their own instruments.
- The duration of the performance is 3 minutes.

MUSIC AROUND YOU:

- This is a team event. Team participation is restricted to 8 members.
- Participants should build a rhythm using everyday objects like vessels, desks, Buckets, and stationery items.
- The duration of the performance is 3 minutes.

MUSICAL STORY TELLING COMPETITION:

- This is a team event.
- Team participation is restricted to 2 to 4 members.
- Compose a short musical storytelling song on given theme on College life.

LYRICS WRITING WITH TUNE:

- This is a team event.
- Team participation is restricted to 4 members.
- The theme/topic is on the friendship.
- The task is to write lyrics on the theme, compose, tune, and sing.
- The theme/topic: Friendship.
- Participants should compose and sing a short musical storytelling song on the given theme.

SOLO DANCE:

- Only individual participants are allowed.
- The time limit is 3-5 minutes, exceeding this limit will result in reduction of marks.
- A valid college ID card is mandatory for all the participation.
- Participants are required to bring their music in mp3 format in a pen drive.
- Mixing of tracks is allowed.
- Usage of props is permitted. However, breakable or flammable objects (such as fire, colors, powder or water) are strictly prohibited.
- Vulgarly or obscenity will not be tolerated.
- Judging Criteria:
- Judging will be based on Choreography, Costume, Energy, Expression, Stage utilization, Stage presence and Overall impact.
- The jury's decision is final.
- It is mandatory for each participant to fill the registration form and hand over the song to coordinators before the event

GROUP DANCE:

- Each team should consist of 4 to 10 participants.
- The time limit is 3-4 minutes, exceeding this limit will result in reduction of marks.
- A valid college ID card is mandatory for all the participants.
- Participants are required to bring their music in mp3 format in a pen drive.
- Mixing of tracks is allowed.
- Usage of props is permitted. However, breakable or flammable objects (such as fire, colors, powder, or water) are strictly prohibited.
- Vulgarly or obscenity will not be tolerated.
- Judging Criteria:
- Judging will be based on Choreography, Costume, Energy, Synchronization, Expression, Stage utilization, Stage presence and Overall impact.
- The jury's decision is final.
- It is mandatory for each team to fill the form below and upload the song in the same.
- hand over the song to coordinators before the event

PERFORMATIVE MARTIAL ARTS:

- Participants can participate individually or as a team.
- Team participation is limited to 4 members.
- Martial arts like Silambam, Kalaripayattu, Taekwondo, and Adimurai can be showcased.
- The duration is 2 minutes.

MIME:

- Participants express a message or a story without speaking, by using only gestures and body movements.
- Each team can have 4-8 participants.
- The performance time must be between 4 to 6 minutes.
- Dialogue, background narration, or verbal expressions are not allowed.
- Only instrumental music are permitted.
- Teams may bring minimal props and costumes, but they must be managed by the team itself.
- In case of any inappropriate or offensive gestures the teams will be disqualified.
- Theme/Title: Climate Change.
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PUPPETRY:

- Participants narrate a story using only puppets.
- Only 2-6 members are allowed per team.
- Performance should be completed within given time limit of 6 to 7 mins.
- The story must be entirely in English.
- Participants may use any kind of handmade puppets.
- Title/Theme: Folk Stories.
- The participants will be cancelled if they use vulgar theme or words during the narration.

ART COMPETITION:

- This is an individual event.
- The theme/topic will be given on the spot.
- Participants can use drawing or painting in any medium, such as acrylic, poster colours, colour pencils, or pencil sketches.
- Participants should bring their own materials.

SHORT FILM CONTEST:

- This is a team event with a maximum of 6 members.
- The theme/topic: Mental Health.
- The short film must be on the given theme.
- Participants can take on one or more roles.
- The duration of the short film is 5 minutes. \

FASHION DESIGNING:

- This is a team event with 6 to 8 participants.
- The theme is "Modern/traditional fusion".
- Participants must choose a concept and design a fashion product, which can be clothing, an abstract object, or body art.
- The art and concept must be presented on stage.
- The time limit is one hour for designing and preparation, and 5 minutes for the presentation.

3D ART:

- Participants can participate as individuals or as teams.
- Team participation is restricted to 4 members.
- The theme/topic: Free Style.
- Participants can use sculpture/art works made from recycled material.
- Participants should bring their own material.

DIGITAL POSTER MAKING:

- This competition is open to both individual and team participation.
- Team participation is restricted to a maximum of 3 members.
- Participants can use their mobile phones or laptops.
- The theme is "Food Heritage of TamilNadu".
- The duration is 30 minutes for designing and 3 minutes for the presentation to the jury.

YOUTH PARLIAMENT:

- The competition is open to team participation only.
- Each team must consist of 4 members
- The theme/topic: Socio Economic Development of Tamil Nadu.
- Participants must adhere to the theme throughout their discussion.
- Teams may present their points, counter arguments, or seek clarifications from other teams.
- Each participant will be allotted 3 minutes to speak.
- Use of offensive, inappropriate, or irrelevant content will lead to disqualification.

STARTUP SIRUTHAI (IDEA MANI):

- This is an individual event.
- There is no specific theme for this competition.
- Participants can choose any theme of their choice.
- The event requires participants to present ideas that have the potential to become future startups or companies.
- Examples of ideas could be setting up a shop, a restaurant, or a boutique.
- The presentation duration is 3 minutes, followed by a 2-minute session for questions and discussion with the judges.

DEBATE COMPETITION:

- Participation is open to teams of 2 members. Each team will have one member speaking for the topic and one against.
- The theme/topic will be given on the spot.
- The debate will be conducted in 3 rounds:
 - Round 1: Each team presents their own views (3 minutes).
 - Round 2: Teams debate the views of the opposing team (2 minutes).
 - Round 3: Teams consolidate their points and conclude (1 minute).
- Speeches may be delivered in English or Tamil.
- Participants must avoid offensive, discriminatory, or inappropriate content; violation may lead to disqualification.
- Title/Theme: Superstition Vs Science

STAND-UP COMEDY:

- The competition is open to individual participants only.
- Participants must perform a stand-up comedy act based on the given theme.
- The theme/topic: College life, employment or daily struggles.
- Each participant will be allotted 3 minutes for their performance.
- The act must be original, clean, and appropriate.
- Use of offensive, vulgar, or discriminatory content will lead to disqualification.

NATURE COLLAGE:

- This is an individual event.
 - Participants should make a collage using objects found in nature like flowers and leaves.
 - A variety of textures, colours, and materials have to be used creatively.
- Participants should bring their own material
- Theme/Topic: Nature.

COOKING WITHOUT FIRE:

- Team participation with a minimum of 3 members and a maximum of 5 members.
- Only fresh, uncooked ingredients can be used to prepare healthy dishes.
- Ingredients may include fruits, vegetables, cereals, or pulses.
- Ready-mix or precooked items are not allowed, except for garnishing purposes.
- Duration of the event is one hour, including both preparation and presentation.
- Teams must present their dish to the judges and provide a brief explanation of the preparation process.
- Creativity, hygiene, presentation, and nutritional value will be considered for evaluation.
- Use of fire, stoves, or electrical appliances for cooking is strictly prohibited.

SHOW AND TELL RULES:

- The competition is open to individual participants only.
- Participants must bring a flower, leaf, or any naturally occurring element from their locality or campus.
- Participants will have to speak about the element in relation to their life, its characteristics, or imagine it as a living being with emotions trying to understand the world.
- The talk should be original and presented during the contest.
- Plagiarism or use of pre-prepared scripts is strictly prohibited.
- The presentation duration may be set by the organizers; participants should ensure clarity, coherence, and engagement.
- Offensive, discriminatory, or inappropriate content is strictly prohibited.
- Theme/Topic: Nature.

NATURAL PHOTOGRAPHY CONTEST:

- This is an individual event.
- The theme/topic: Nature.
- A series of pictures must be shot on the day of the competition.
- Participants must build a narrative using the pictures they shot.
- All pictures should be centered on the main theme.
- The time frame is one hour to take photos and 30 minutes to edit and build the narrative.
- The presentation before the judges has a duration of 3 minutes.
