During the conduct of Faculty development programmes and staff and student training Faculty/Experts from industry come in Car to GCE, Bargur to deliver expert lectures. As per Tamilnadu Govt. norms Rs 8/ per Km of distance travelled can be given for 320 Kms only. (To and fro put together). Since GCE, Bargur is neither connected directly by Train nor by Flight, to reach GCE, Bargur:

- i) Experts either come to Jolarpettai and travel 45-55 Kms by road,
- ii) Or reach Dharmapuri and travel 75 Kms through some other mode of travel which becomes very tedious.

Reaching the college in time to deliver expert lecture becomes a tension to experts. Normally Experts come in car and in the already conducted programmes-FDPs, SDPs, Training by industry experts Travel allowance was given as Rs 8/per Km of distance travelled without any distance constraints.

Permission is requested to ratify the already given TA of Rs 8/per Km of distance travelled in all the programmes conducted at GCE, Bargur and further continuance of the same TA norms for future programmes also.

Due to heavy power cut in this region it is difficult to conduct regular practical class works. Dept. of Mechanical Engineering requires three phase power to run machineries like lathe, shaping machine, drilling machine etc.

Similarly Administrative block also requires alternate power supply for the conduct of Examination work, daily administration work and computer lab classes. In Anna University, Chennai internal mark entry, attendance entry, hall ticket downloading and generation is done by the respective college. Mark entry after lab Examination is in online mode. Everything related to Examination is made online and the entry must be made in Examination office confidentially. Examination office is in the administrative block and it requires continuous power supply. It is proposed to purchase two Diesel Generators of 62.5 KVA or above.

During Mentor's visit it was suggested that each department should have drinking water facility. Hence it is proposed to install Reverse Osmosis machine in all the departments.
